## Datasheet DW-SOHO-M-20



The Analog Trunk FXO (Foreign Exchange Office) is an interface that connects to a trunk line FXO interfaces are used to connect your SOHO to the PSTN. One FXO channel is required for each line you receive from your telco.

The DW-SOHO-M-20 provides analog connectivity to analog central office loop start trunk line analog interfaces.

The loop start DW-SOHO-M-20 provides the following features:

- Detects ringing when on-hook
- Detects loop current when off-hook
- Detects when tip/ring voltage crosses a set voltage when on-hook or off-hook (called DC triggering)
- Can accommodate the SOHO with -48 V battery voltage
- Loop current range: 13-110mA
- Voltage detection threshold is software-selectable
