Denwa LDAP

Introduction:

Denwa LDAP is recommended for private, banking and government institutions that use a user management and management system through platforms such as Active Directory (AD) or Novell Directory Services (eDirectory), among others.

Features:

- Contact synchronization and user management from a single platform is one of the most widely used tools regardless of the size of organizations.
- The tendency to centralize the administration, leads to the necessity that, independently of the platform, through a common means to manage the contacts by areas and subareas. In addition, this management allows to enable users to different services within the organization.
- The most used protocol within the management platforms is the LDAP, and Denwa incorporates through the LDAP modules the ability to interact with these platforms.

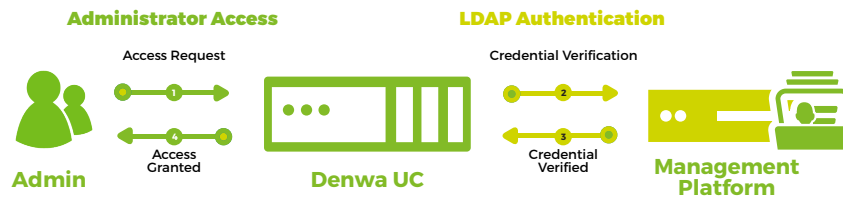

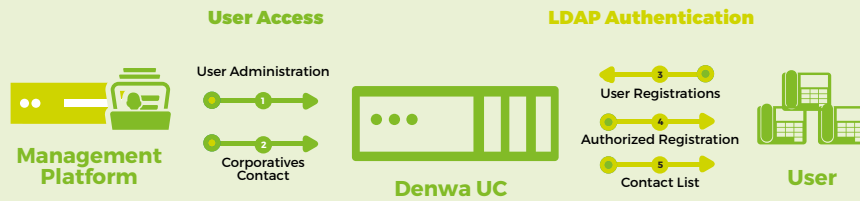
Scopes:



MD-LDAP-CA: This module allows the authentication of the Administrators of Denwa UC in the platform of Management through the LDAP



MD-LDAP-CU: This module allows the synchronization of users and corporate contacts (creation, modification and elimination) from the Management platform to Denwa UC.



MD-LDAP-SAC: This module allows the synchronization of calendar events (activities, tasks, meetings) and synchronization of the Contacts directory from Denwa UC through an AddIn developed for Outlook 2010 versions onwards.
